

# STUDENT BUS TRAVEL

I would like to remind parents, and our students, of the Code of Conduct for school students on buses. The Code is printed on a separate page.

When a parent signs an application for a Bus Pass for their child to travel to and from school, the following agreement is made.

*I have read and agree with the Code of Conduct.*

*I have explained the Code of Conduct to my son / daughter and he/ she agrees to abide by the code.*

*I also understand that subsidized travel may be suspended or withdrawn for serious breaches of the code.*

*I declare that the information I have provided on this declaration is accurate and true.*

*I have read the instructions and agree to the conditions of the scheme as detailed in the covering instruction sheet.*

Students are expected to behave in a safe and sensible manner when traveling on buses and while moving between buses at the bus interchange (near St. Carthage's).

# CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SCHOOL STUDENTS ON BUSES

TO ENSURE YOUR SAFETY AND THE COMFORT OF  
OTHER PASSENGERS

Students will:

Behave safely at all times.

Respect the needs and comfort of other passengers.

Behave appropriately at all times  
(e.g. No use of offensive language, fighting, spitting,  
placing feet on seats or throwing things in or from  
the bus).

Protect bus property and report any vandalism.

Show their travel passes or ticket to the driver on  
boarding and when requested.

Maintain possession of the travel pass at all times.

Follow the driver's instructions about safety on the bus  
(e.g. Instructions on where to sit).

Adhere to the law that bans smoking on buses.

Only eat or drink (other than water) on the bus with the  
written permission of the bus operator.

Keep arms, legs and other parts of their bodies inside  
the bus.

Only attract the attention of the driver in the case of an  
emergency.
