

Grey shorts

GIRLS Blue polo neck shirt  
(printed with School Crest)

Blue sports style skirt or blue shorts

Covered shoes

HATS A blue cloth (wide brimmed) hat is  
the recommended style

WINTER Both boys and girls wear royal blue  
jumper or track suit

## **SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY**

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

School Uniform for boys

grey shorts, blue polo neck shirt and covered shoes

School Uniform for girls

Blue skirt or shorts, blue polo neck shirt and covered  
shoes.

In winter both boys and girls may also wear a royal blue  
track suit.

## **SUN PROTECTION**

All students should wear a hat that provides sun protection.

## **SAFETY, RESPECT & PRIDE**

When dressing for school or casually parents and children should be aware of safety concerns and respect for and pride in ourselves.

## **DRESS**

The choice of clothing, should always take into account an appropriate level of sun protection.

If casual clothing is worn it should cover the same amount of the body, as would be expected in a school uniform and protect areas of the body such as the shoulders; singlets are not appropriate.

## **FOOTWEAR**

Footwear should cover the feet, provide protection and be comfortable.

Footwear such as sandals, thongs, slip-on shoes with no backs or high heels are not appropriate.

## **HATS FOR SUN PROTECTION**

Children should wear a hat for all outdoor activities.

A “no hat, play in the shade” rule applies to all students when outside.

## **GENERAL**

Long hair should be tied back. This helps prevent transmission of head lice.

The choice of dress should show respect.

Clothing with offensive designs or clothing which is “revealing” is not appropriate at school.
